Our successful candidate will be a warm and welcoming RECE who has a passion for working with children with additional support needs; has experience in the Early Learning and Care and Children's Mental Health sectors and is ready for an opportunity to build their coaching and mentoring skills in a consultation role.

to different childcare centre locations within the West Geographical Service Area of Toronto.
