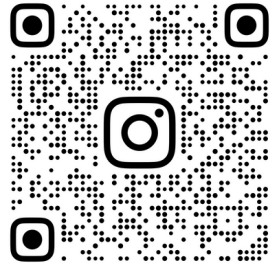

## **Family Drop-In (Birth to 6 years of age)**

A wonderful opportunity for children and their family to participate in early learning activities and to enjoy the use of play materials, equipment and resources. This program is designed to encourage quality adult and child interactions in an age-appropriate, child-focused environment that enhances and promotes healthy child development

## **Baby's World (Birth to 18 months)**

This program welcomes parents/caregivers to experience the joy of sharing songs, rhymes and musical activities with their infants. Families will have the opportunity to socialize, ask questions, and share helpful hints or strategies with each other while spending quality time with their babies. This program offers resources and services available within the community.

## **Dad's and Kids (Birth to 6 years of age) \*(Registration required)**

This special program offers fathers' the opportunity to engage with other dads. They will be able to network with others and share new experiences, ideas, concerns, and their expertise as fathers. This interactive program enhances and promotes healthy child development by providing activities to enhance skills in all areas of development.

## **Learning and Growing Together for Black Families Drop-In**

A wonderful opportunity for black children and their families to participate in early learning activities and to enjoy the use of play materials, equipment and resources that are culturally relevant. This program is designed to encourage quality adult and child interaction in an age-appropriate, child focused, and culturally appropriate environment that enhances and promotes healthy child development.

## **Sensory Play (Birth to 6 years of age)**

This program welcomes children and their families to experience play through the use of their senses. Each week we will focus on one sense such as tactile, sound, sight, smell, taste as well as vestibular (balance) and proprioceptive input (using muscles). Children will have the opportunity to enhance their senses through crafts, group time with songs and finger plays and age appropriate activities.

## **Quiet Play Program (Birth to 6 years of age) \*\*(Registration required)**

Parents/caregivers and their children are welcome to play together and discover the world through their senses. The nurturing, calm environment enhances learning experiences that support healthy child development. Families will have the opportunity to connect with each other, as well as get information on various community supports and resources.
